- It is approved as a fertilizer and registered with the Vermont Department of Agriculture.
- Earthlife is made from organic materials, and its ingredients occur naturally in the environment and the resource cycle.

## It's Good for the Environment.

- Earthlife's environmental benefits start with the fact that it is a renewed (recycled) resource.
- Unlike traditional inorganic or synthetic fertilizers that use high levels of nitrogen and phosphorus, Earthlife has a "lighter" presence, that more closely resembles nature's own fertilization cycles and inputs.
- It is a "slow release" fertilizer, providing a lasting benefit over time. Traditional fertilizers are "quick flush," and lose their nutrients with the first rain, which can also cause problems in waterways.
- It is an organic-derived fertilizer, which holds its nutrients better and improves soil quality, fertility and water-holding capacity.
